

POLICY: Uniform and Grooming Policy



1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to describe Jubilee Primary School's approach to the consistent management of student uniforms and grooming.

2. RATIONALE

In accordance with section 360 of the [Education \(General Provisions\) Act 2006](#) (Qld), a dress code will apply when students are attending, or representing, the school.

School uniforms perform several important functions within the overall operation of schools, including:

- fostering a sense of school community and shared mission
- increasing a sense of belonging and engagement
- promoting health and safety and
- encouraging respect in self and school.

Students in uniform also represent their school and therefore play a central role in the presentation of Jubilee Primary School to the broader community.

3. POLICY STATEMENT

The children who attend Jubilee Primary School are required to wear the school's uniform and meet the desired grooming expectations. All of which are outlined below. It is also expected that children who attend Jubilee Primary School follow these requirements whilst travelling to and from school as they are representatives of our school community. This also includes any other times where children are representatives of our school.

Students are expected to be presented neatly at all times and in the appropriate school uniform and that it is worn appropriately at all times with pride.

Hair must be kept neat and tidy at all times:

- *Hair at or below shoulder length must be tied back with either white or navy scrunchies, ribbons, elastics or clips*
- *Hair should be its natural colour and styles must be conservative. Short hair styles should be no closer than a number two cut. Less conservative haircuts/styles including razor patterns, boys' hair tied on top of head, Mohawks, shaved or undercut mullets are not permitted.*
- *Hair is to be kept off the face. If boy's hair naturally falls over the eyes, it is expected that hair will be kept short enough so as not to distract or impede eyesight.*

It is essential that all items of clothing be clearly marked with your child's name.

School shoes are to be kept clean and polished. If other specialised shoes are to be worn for specialised events, including basketball boots, athletics spikes, football boots etc., students are to bring them to school and can change into them for the event only.

In keeping with the ideals of a sun safe school, Jubilee Primary School has a NO HAT - NO PLAY policy. Hats should be worn correctly and whenever students are involved in lunch, play, or other school related activities.

Make-up, including nail polish, is not permitted.

Religious necklace/medals, alert tags, wristwatches and earrings may be worn at Jubilee Primary School. All other forms of jewellery are not permitted.

If wearing earrings, then sleepers no larger than 1 cm diameter or plain studs, one in the lobe of each ear is acceptable.

Smartwatches also fall into the category of our Acceptable Use Agreements. Should students use these inappropriately they will need to be removed and collected at the end of the day. Persistent misuse will mean they are no longer permitted.

No body art or body piercing is acceptable.

4. PRINCIPLES

To assist Jubilee Primary School to manage this policy, it applies the following principles when developing, revising and approving student dress codes:

- Consultation with staff and the Parent and Friends association has occurred.
- The school uniform and grooming policy is consistent with health and safety considerations, e.g. sun safe, protective clothing, clothing appropriate to curriculum activities.
- The school uniform and grooming policy is consistent with anti-discrimination and human rights legislation.
- The school uniform and grooming policy contributes to the wellbeing of students by providing adequate protection from the elements and a degree of comfort that allows for full participation in all school activities, including play, sport and other physical and recreational activities.
- The school uniform can be sourced from a local seller. If unavailable, modifications can be discussed and applied where appropriate.

- The school uniform and grooming expectations are appropriate for participation in our Ecumenical school and daily routines, e.g. formal and sport.
